Hong Kong's stress relief management tops the world

Grant Thornton International Business Report found that only 39% of Hong Kong privately held business owners said their stress levels have increased over the past year, compared to 67% in 2007, showing the world's biggest drop (28%) in stress levels. In relation to major causes of workplace pressure, surprisingly 27% of Hong Kong business owners said they had no stress, followed by heavy workload (25%) and economic climate (24%).

Business owners in Mainland China, together with those from countries with high GDP growth namely Mexico, Turkey, Vietnam, all feature high on the stress league table. The survey also found a correlation between stress levels and the number of days off taken by an individual in a year. By contrast those countries where business owners had more stress than a year ago had taken fewer holidays.

on down the street between \$1,120 and \$1,125 when suddenly it keeled over - WHAM! then gapped down just above \$1,115 and hit \$1,107 before it began trading sideways even a little.

European debt concerns will continue to drive the bullion market at least until European leaders show a united front. The decision by the Reserve Bank of India to raise base interest rates on Friday came as a surprise to many and is having a knock-on effect on risk sentiment so far this week.

Conclusion:

Indeed, concerns over Greece's debt situation and the possibility of contagion should be bullish for bullion, one might think, and may still turn out to be so. In addition, any revaluation by China of its currency is also likely to be bullish for gold - it would make the yellow metal cheaper in local currency.
